



Agenda for CSLF European Stakeholder meeting

The Carbon Sequestration Leadership Forum (CSLF) is a Ministerial-level international climate change initiative focused on the development of improved cost-effective technologies for CCS.

Scope of the meeting

Recognising that CO₂ Capture and Storage (CCS) development varies from region to region, the CSLF is implementing regional stakeholder events designed to capture and reflect the diverse stakeholder needs that must be met to achieve successful implementation of CCS success in each geographic region. CO₂GeoNet and the Carbon Capture Storage Association (CCSA) will host the first CSLF Regional European event. This event aims to capture the views of one of the four regions identified by the CSLF, which are 1) Americas, 2) Europe, 3) Asia & Pacific and 4) Middle East & Africa.

Dialogue and feedback received from stakeholders through all four regional events will provide the basis for a message to the CSLF Ministers at the annual meeting this December. Attendees are encouraged to actively participate in the discussion as their input will assist the formulation of stakeholder messages which will be presented to Ministers

Ahead of the European regional event, an online survey will be used to request input from stakeholders. The results of this questionnaire will be used as a starting point for discussion during the event.
