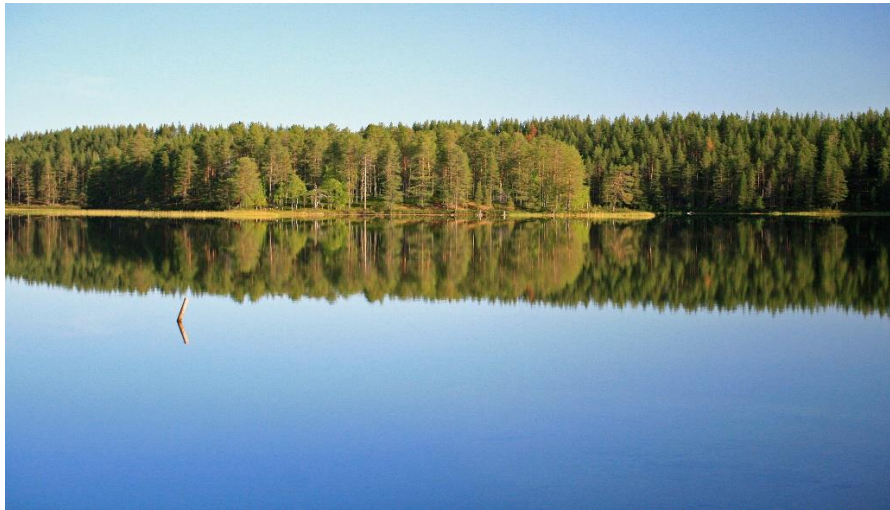


## “ENVIRONMENT, SOCIAL AND GOVERNANCE ASSESSMENTS AND CCUS”
