Widespread global deployment of CCS will require that CCS move from research status through demonstration projects to commercial operation. Diverse projects will need to be financed, constructed and operated, and in different markets.

The Financing CCS Task Force will work with industry, the financial community, and other stakeholders to formulate and promote viable business models for the commercial deployment of CCS. Different business models may be required because of differences in industries, energy markets and regulatory regimes; but all business models will need to provide an appropriate balance of risks and rewards to all participants, including the public. Business models will need to adapt as the technology matures and the constituent businesses evolve.
