## Technical Group Outcomes

- Invite the IEA GHG to the next meeting to make a presentation on their “Capture Ready” study.
- The final report from the Task Force to review and Identify Standards for CO<sub>2</sub> Storage Capacity Estimation Phase II has been accepted. The study will be posted on the CSLF website subject to minor wording changes.
- Phase III of the Task Force will move forward. Three recommendations for future work have been supported.
- Three additional members have volunteered for the Task Force to Examine Risk Assessment. IEA is active in this area and has joined the task force.



## Technical Group Outcomes

- Establishment of a new Joint Task Force between the Technical and Policy Groups on the topic of examining societal issues impacting CCS deployment.
  - Australia has volunteered to lead with Denmark and possibly France as participants.



## Technical Group Outcomes

- Overcoming Barriers to CCS Deployment Workshop was reviewed by the Technical Group and discussed.
  - Good balance of public and private participants.
  - Underscored importance of communication.
  - Positive feedback from stakeholders and well attended.
- Secretariat to develop a survey and distribute it to attendees.
- PIRT reported that the Action Plan activity was under control and that long-term planning may help support resource issues.

- Await response from Saudi Arabia on next Technical Group meeting.
- Otway Basin and Zama Projects were reviewed and approved by the PIRT and the Technical Group.
